READ THIS PART FIRST, PLEASE: IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- 1). ALL REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT are to be completed ONLINE at www.kwpfo.org/enrichment. Our registration website is mobile-friendly (Apple and Android devices). If you do not have computer/internet access to register, please contact hello@kwpfo.org for assistance. DO NOT CONTACT SCHOOL ADMIN ABOUT REGISTRATION. They have no information and cannot help you with registration.
- 2). **The registration deadline is March 11, 2024.** Registration after March 11, 2024 will be on discretion if there are open class spots. Classes will begin March 18th and each class will have 8 to 10 sessions each. If an instructor misses a class, a make up class may be offered after the last day of classes at the instructor's discretion. Please refer to the enclosed catalog for specific dates. Registration will firmly close upon the first day of classes. If a class does not reach its minimum participation the class will be canceled and the tuition will be refunded.
- 3). Classes will be filled in the order that registration AND payment are completed and received. Your student will not be enrolled until payment is received. Register early to ensure a spot in the class.
- 4). **CONSIDER YOURSELF REGISTERED – PLAN TO ATTEND CLASS ON THE FIRST DAY.** You will be notified if the class has been canceled or is already full; in either of these cases, your payment will be returned to you (or you can choose another class). We will not be posting class lists.
- 5). **There are certain classes that will need one parent proctor. *Please indicate if you are interested in serving as proctor when registering.*** If you are selected as proctor, the class fee for your child will be waived. Parent proctors will assist the instructor with gathering students prior to class, taking attendance, supporting class activities, etc. The parent proctor must attend EVERY CLASS; if your child drops out of the class, you are required to continue your volunteer duties or find someone who can be your replacement. If a class that requires a volunteer parent proctor does not have a parent volunteer that class will be canceled and the tuition refunded. **Parent proctors need to be registered volunteers—if you need help getting registered please contact us at enrichment@kwpfo.org.**
- 6). Class dates and times may vary, so please MARK YOUR CALENDAR accordingly. It is your responsibility to know when classes will be held. Your child must be picked up within five (5) minutes of the class end time. Instructors are not responsible for your child after the class ends. Repeated tardiness in picking up your child will result in him/her being dropped from the class without a refund.
- 7). **There will be no refunds provided after the first class,** regardless of reason. Failure to follow instructor roles and policies may also result in removal from a class, with no refund provided.

Robot Building Workshop with Parker Anderson

About This Class: Learn about basic robotics and the construction of robots in class while also creating your own robots that walk, crawl, and roll (you get to keep them and take them home!). Explore engineering principles while working with levers, gears, batteries, screw drivers, and motors as you build amazing robots with a variety of materials. Kids will enjoy tinkering with their own robots and working with their friends on robot challenges. This is a great class for kids that like to work with small tools, build and take apart things to see how they work, enjoy problem solving and have an interest in robotics.



Skateboarding with Intro2Skate

About This Class: Learn how to skate or improve your skills with Intro2Skate after school. Skilled instructors guide kids to safely learn the basics, intermediate and advanced/ new tricks on their mobile skatepark ramps. All levels of skateboarders will enjoy this class and it is a fun way to be allowed to skateboard on school premises! Skateboard, helmet, knee and elbow pads are required. If you already have your own, please bring them to the class every week. If you do not have any gear you Intro2Skate will have gear available to borrow for each class. Let's skate!

There will be a student art show on the last day of class where students can show off their wonderful creations and artistic expression to friends and family.



Musical Theater with Active Learning

About This Class: This class provides instructional classes in voice, dance, acting and performance. Students choose from a variety of classical and contemporary shows and will vote on which performance they want to work on together. Students really enjoyed this class last semester and they put on a great performance on the last day of classes for parents and family. This class is a longer class (125 minutes) and it is important for your student to commit to attending all classes since the class is working on putting together a cohesive group performance. This is a great class for those that want a chance to perform with less pressure or who would like to build on the skills they learned for the recent school play.
