READ THIS PART FIRST, PLEASE: IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1). ALL REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT are to be completed ONLINE at <u>www.kwpfo.org/enrichment</u>. Our registration website is mobile-friendly (Apple and Android devices). If you do not have computer/internet access to register, please contact <u>hello@kwpfo.org</u> for assistance. DO NOT CONTACT SCHOOL ADMIN ABOUT REGISTRATION. They have no information and cannot help you with registration.

2). **The registration deadline is September 29**. Registration after September 29 will be by discretion if there are open class spots. Classes will begin October 4 and each class will have 7 or 8 sessions each. If an instructor misses a class, a make-up class may be offered after the last day of scheduled classes or a partial refund issued at the instructor's discretion. Please refer to the enclosed catalog for specific dates. Registration will firmly close upon the first day of classes. If a class does not reach its minimum participation the class will be canceled and paid tuition will be refunded.

3). Classes will be filled in the order that registration AND payment are completed and received. Your student will not be enrolled until payment is received. Register early to ensure a spot in the class.

4). CONSIDER YOURSELF REGISTERED – PLAN TO ATTEND CLASS ON THE FIRST DAY. You will be notified if the class has been canceled or is already full; in either of these cases, your payment will be returned to you (or you can choose another class). We will not be posting class lists.

5). There are certain classes that will need one parent proctor. *Please indicate if you are interested in serving as proctor when registering.* If you are selected as proctor, the class fee for your child will be waived. Parent proctors will assist the instructor with gathering students prior to class, taking attendance, supporting class activities, etc. The parent proctor must attend EVERY CLASS; if your child drops out of the class, you are required to continue your volunteer duties or find someone who can be your replacement. If a class that requires a volunteer parent proctor does not have a parent volunteer that class will be canceled and the tuition refunded. <u>Parent proctors need to be registered volunteers-if you need help getting registered please contact us at enrichment@kwpfo.org.</u>

6). Class dates and times may vary, so please MARK YOUR CALENDAR accordingly. It is your responsibility to know when classes will be held. Your child must be picked up within five (5) minutes of the class end time. Instructors are not responsible for your child after the class ends. Repeated tardiness in picking up your child will result in him/her being dropped from the class without a refund.

7). There will be no refunds provided after the first class, regardless of reason. Failure to follow instructor roles and policies may also result in removal from a class, with no refund provided.

Musical Theater with Active Learning

Dates: MONDAYS; October 7, 14, 28, November 4, 18, 25, December 2, 9 Time: 2:55pm-4:30pm (90 -minute class) Note: No classes October 21, November 11 Location: MPR Fee: \$210 (\$26.25 per class for 8 classes) Class size: Minimum 5 students needed Parent proctor needed.

About This Class: Musical Theater is a fun and instructional class that teaches kids how to sing, dance, act and perform together in a popular Broadway musical. Students will choose from a variety of classical and contemporary shows and vote on which performance they want to work on together this semester. There will be a live performance on the last day of class (December 9th) for parents and family and every student will have a part in the show. This class is a longer class (90 minutes) and it is important for your student to commit to attending all classes since the class is working on putting together a cohesive group performance. This is a great class for those that want a chance to practice their acting skills with a guaranteed part in a musical production. Musical Theater welcomes back students from last school year who would like to take the class again and work on a different musical!



Marine Biology with Parker Anderson

Dates: MONDAYS; October 7, 14, 28, November 4, 18, December 2, 9, 16 Time: 2:55-3:55 (60-minute class) Note: No classes October 21, November 11, 25 Location: Classroom 32 Fee: \$165 (\$20.63 per class for 8 classes) Class size: Minimum 5 students needed Parent proctor needed.

About This Class: Explore the diversity of ocean life from organisms in hot deep sea vents, to tropical fish, to the astonishing varieties of arctic marine life! Participate in class dissections of a lamprey eel, a crayfish and even a dogfish shark (subject to change based on availability)! Write with squid ink, grow Sea Monkeys, and learn about the largest environment on the planet!

TUESDAY CLASSES



Learn to DJ with Active Learning

Dates: TUESDAYS: October 8, 15, 29, November 5, 12, 19, December 3, 10 Time: 2:55-3:55 (60-minute class) Note: No classes October 22, November 26 Location: Classroom 32 Fee: \$160 (\$20 per class for 8 classes) Class size: Minimum 3 students needed *No parent proctor needed.*

About This Class: Students will learn a wide range of skills in music production. The curriculum incorporates fundamental proficiency in mixing music, beat matching, track selection, programming a mix and genre studies. Over the course of the classes, students will create their own music mixes and design their own DJ logos all while having a great time playing music and mixing beats with their peers. Students will participate in a performance for friends and family on the last day of class so others can check out their newly learned skills! Returning students are encouraged to sign up again to build on the skills they learned last semester.



Cheer with Active Learning

About This Class: Students will learn team building exercises and the fundamentals of cheerleading such as cheer motion dance, beginning tumbling, chants, jumps, kicks, and voice projection. This is a great introduction to cheer for those interested in joining the Ensign cheer squad in 7th grade or for students just looking to have fun with their friends building routines to popular songs and improving their jumps and kicks. Students should wear comfortable clothing appropriate for cheer (sweatpants, shorts, socks, sneakers).



Golf with TGA

Dates: TUESDAYS: October 8, 15, 29, November 5, 12, 19, December 3, 10 Time: 2:55-3:55 (60-minute class) Note: No classes October 22, November 26 Location: Outdoor/ grass field at Kaiser Fee: \$206.00 (\$25.75 per class for 8 classes, includes use of clubs) Class size: Minimum 4 students needed Parent proctor needed.

About This Class: Students will be taught the game of golf through easy-to-understand concepts & interactive games that are fun and engaging. Golf instructors use skill-based drills that can be done anywhere (indoors or outdoors, at school, or on the golf course) to help students develop the fundamentals of golf, explore academic concepts through game play, and practice life skills — such as sportsmanship and respect. Students will be hitting NERF golf balls in lieu of standard golf balls for safety purposes. This class was a big hit with students that attended it last year and previous students are invited back to continue to improve their golf game!

Skateboarding with Intro2Skate

Dates: WEDNESDAYS: October 9, 16, 30, November 6, 13, 20, December 4, 11 Time: 1:45-2:45 (60-minute class) Note: No classes October 23, November 27 Location: Kaiser blacktop Fee: \$320 (\$40 a class includes the use of skateboards and safety equipment) Class size: Minimum 5 students needed *No parent proctor needed*.

About This Class: Learn how to skate or improve your skills with Intro2Skate after school. Skilled instructors guide kids to safely learn the basics, intermediate and advanced/ new tricks on their mobile skatepark ramps. All levels of skateboarders will enjoy this class and it is a fun way to be allowed to skateboard on school premises! Skateboard, helmet, knee and elbow pads are required. If you already have your own, please bring them to the class every week. If you do not have any gear you Intro2Skate will have gear available to borrow for each class. Let's skate!



Minecraft Builders (Parker Anderson)

About This Class: Come join us to learn about and play the most popular computer game on the planet! Learn Minecraft building techniques, details of commands, and how to change the look of the game by playing on the provided devices. Students learn strategy, building, and cooperation skills while playing Minecraft in a fun, safe, and supervised environment! (Students are welcome to bring their own devices to play Minecraft, but devices will be provided for students who don't wish to bring their own.)



Professor Egghead Astronauts

About This Class: Blast off this session with the Egghead Astronaut Crew as we explore the far reaches of our universe. Students will set off rockets, make huge chemical reactions, make lava slime, look for life and rocks on other planets, recycle water in space, and make out of this world volcanoes on their way to becoming astronauts! The best part? They get to take home their experiment every week! At the end of the session, students will receive their own Egghead Astronaut Degree.

About This Class: Great way for kids to get some exercise with friends after school on Wednesdays! Each week focuses on a different sport, teaching the basics of flag football, soccer, basketball, baseball/softball and pickleball. Emphasis on fun and participation! All classes are led by experienced and certified coaches who prioritize safety and fun. This is the same program that provided the sports program for the summer school enrichment program at Mariners this year and it was a huge hit with the kids. *Equipment Needed: Comfortable athletic wear, sneakers, water bottle.
