PLEASE read the important information about enrollment and payment below:

- 1) **NEW THIS YEAR**: All enrollment and payment will be completed directly with each enrichment provider using links provided on **Saturday, September 13**th @ 9am at kwpfo.org/enrichment.
- 2) **Enrollment closes at 11:59pm on Monday, September 22nd**. Enrollment decisions after the deadline will be determined by the class provider. Classes will be filled in the order that registration & payment are completed and received. Your student will not be enrolled until payment is received. Register early to ensure a spot in the class.

CONSIDER YOURSELF REGISTERED – PLAN TO ATTEND CLASS ON THE FIRST DAY. We will not be posting class lists. You will be notified if the class has been canceled due to low enrollment and your class *tuition will be refunded*.

- 3) Classes will begin week of Monday, October 6th and each class will have 8 sessions. If an instructor misses a class, a make-up class may be offered after the last day of classes at the instructor's discretion. Please refer to the course catalog for specific dates for each class. Enrollment will firmly close upon the first day of classes.
- 4) All communication regarding enrollment, refunds, special accommodations, student behavior, & parent concerns will be handled by the provider for that class. Contact information will be provided during enrollment. PLEASE DO NOT CONTACT SCHOOL ADMIN ABOUT ENRICHMENT CLASS CONCERNS. They have no information and cannot help you with this.
- 5) Class dates and times vary based on school calendar, so please MARK YOUR CALENDAR accordingly. It is your responsibility to know when classes will be held. Your child must be picked up within five (5) minutes of the class end time. Instructors are not responsible for your child after the class ends. Repeated tardiness in picking up your child will result in them being dropped from the class without a refund.
- 6) There will be no refunds provided after the first class, regardless of reason. Participation in enrichment classes is optional. Please note that the structure and accommodations provided during these optional after-school classes may differ from those offered during the regular school day. Student participation in the program is dependent on respectful and safe behavior from students. Any student who is not able to follow directions from the instructor, participate safely, and demonstrate respectful behavior to fellow students and the instructor will be removed from the class. There will be no refund in this case.

LEGO Engineering: Super Structures with Professor Egghead (grades 4-6 only)

They're all structures that can be built with LEGO™ bricks in this session of Egghead Engineering! Join the Egghead team as we design, build, and test LEGO™ bridges, towering skyscrapers, underground tunnels and more in order to learn the foundations of engineering and see what it takes to build the most solid structures imaginable. Each class presents new opportunities for creativity - no challenge is too big for the Egghead team to tackle!

Using skill-based drills that can be done anywhere (indoors or outdoors, at school, or on the golf course), students develop the fundamentals, explore academic concepts through game play, and practice life skills — such as sportsmanship and respect. Students will be hitting NERF golf balls in lieu of standard golf balls for safety purposes.

In this 8-week course, you will learn the complete fundamentals of multiple sports which include: dribbling, shooting, technique, terminology, and friendly scrimmages. Each of the following sports will be split amongst the 8 sessions: Basketball, Soccer, Baseball (Whiffleball), and flag football. Class format: 30 minutes of instruction/drills + 30 minutes of open play where you will have the opportunity to practice what you learned in class. Emphasis is on fun and participation! All classes are led by experienced and certified coaches who prioritize safety and fun.
