Woodland Elementary After-School Enrichment Classes

PLEASE read the important information about enrollment and payment below:

1) **NEW THIS YEAR:** All enrollment and payment will be completed directly with each enrichment provider using links provided on **Wednesday, February 11th @ 12pm at kwpfo.org/enrichment.**

2) **Enrollment closes at midnight on Tuesday, February 24th.** Enrollment decisions after the deadline will be determined by the class provider. Classes will be filled in the order that registration & payment are completed and received. Your student will not be enrolled until payment is received. Register early to ensure a spot in the class.

CONSIDER YOURSELF REGISTERED – PLAN TO ATTEND CLASS ON THE FIRST DAY. We will not be posting class lists. You will be notified if the class has been canceled due to low enrollment and your class *tuition will be refunded*.

3) **Classes will begin week of Monday, March 16th** and each class will have 8 sessions. If an instructor misses a class, a make-up class may be offered after the last day of classes at the instructor's discretion. There will be no class the week of Spring Break. Enrollment will firmly close upon the first day of classes.

4) All communication regarding enrollment, refunds, special accommodations, student behavior, & parent concerns will be handled by the provider for that class. Contact information will be provided during enrollment. **PLEASE DO NOT CONTACT SCHOOL ADMIN ABOUT ENRICHMENT CLASS CONCERNS.** They have no information and cannot help you with this.

5) **Class dates and times vary** based on school calendar, so please **MARK YOUR CALENDAR** accordingly. It is your responsibility to know when classes will be held. Your child must be picked up within five (5) minutes of the class end time. Instructors are not responsible for your child after the class ends. Repeated tardiness in picking up your child will result in them being dropped from the class without a refund.

6) **There will be no refunds provided after the first class**, regardless of reason. Participation in enrichment classes is optional. Please note that the structure and accommodations provided during these optional after-school classes may differ from those offered during the regular school day. Student participation in the program is dependent on respectful and safe behavior from students. Any student who is not able to follow directions from the instructor, participate safely, and demonstrate respectful behavior to fellow students and the instructor will be removed from the class. There will be no refund in this case.

MONDAY CLASSES



LEGO Masters by Parker Anderson

Dates: Begins 3/16 and ends 5/11. No classes during Spring Break (4/6).

Time: 2:35-3:35 pm (60-minute class)

Location: Rm 8

Fee: \$130

Class Size: Minimum 6, Maximum 15

About This Class: This course teaches basic building techniques by working with standard Lego bricks to complete team challenges. Being LEGO Smart is more than building with LEGO bricks--it's having the ability to work in teams, solve problems, and build amazing LEGO creations, as you explore your creativity. Join us for the perfect combination of learning and fun!



Silly Science by Parker Anderson

Dates: Begins 3/16 and ends 5/11. No classes during Spring Break (4/6).

Fee: \$140

Class Size: Minimum: 6, Maximum: 15

About This Class: This science program will delight and astonish young children encountering the wonders of nature for the first time! Experiment with a bit of chemistry, paleontology, physics, and more in this exciting class. Young children will develop a passion for learning about the world around them!



Flag Football with Beyond Athletics

Dates: Begins 3/16 and ends 5/11. No classes during Spring Break (4/6).

Time: 2:35-3:35 pm (60-minute class)

Location: Field

Fee: \$175

Class Size: Minimum: 8, Maximum: 40

About This Class: Flag Football introduces students to the fundamentals of football in a safe, non-contact environment. Participants will learn basic skills such as throwing, catching, flag-pulling, and defensive movement while emphasizing teamwork, communication, and sportsmanship. This class focuses on skill development, confidence building, and having fun through structured drills and game play. A parent-attended showcase will be held on the final day of the program.

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TUESDAY CLASSES



Music and Movement by Active Learning

Dates: Begins 3/17 and ends 5/12. No classes during Spring Break (4/7).

Time: 2:35-3:35 pm (60-minute class)

Location: MPR

Fee: \$200 total (\$160 plus \$40 materials fee)

Class Size: Minimum 3, Maximum 20

About This Class: In Music & Movement, kids sing, dance, jump, and groove while exploring music with their whole bodies! We clap to the beat, move like animals, play fun rhythm games, and use scarves and instruments to feel the music. This class builds listening skills, coordination, creativity, and confidence, all while having tons of fun!



Yoga with mog&yoga

Dates: Begins 3/17 and ends 5/12. No classes during Spring Break (4/7).

Fee: \$165

Class Size: Minimum: 5 , Maximum: 10

About This Class: This class offers a gentle, creative introduction to yoga designed especially for young children. Through playful movement, mindful breathing, and sensory games, children explore the connection between body, mind, and emotions. On occasion, simple art or craft activities may also be included to deepen the mindfulness experience. The goal is to help children develop tools for emotional regulation, focus, and confidence—while having fun in a supportive space.



Spanish Immersion by Parker Anderson

Class Size: Minimum 6, Max 15

About This class: In this class, students will have the opportunity to immerse themselves in the Spanish language and culture. Each class will incorporate art, storytelling, games, and songs to learn Spanish in a fun way! This class is great for new and returning students.

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WEDNESDAY CLASSES



Field Hockey with Beyond Athletics

Dates: Begins 3/18 and ends 5/13. No classes during Spring Break (4/8).

Time: 1:40-2:40 pm (60-minute class)

Location: Field

Fee: \$175

Class Size: Minimum: 6, Maximum: 40

About This class: Field Hockey offers students the opportunity to learn a fast-paced and exciting sport through fun drills and interactive games. Participants will develop hand-eye coordination, stick handling, passing, and spatial awareness while learning the importance of teamwork and fair play. This class is designed to be welcoming to beginners and engaging for all skill levels. A parent-attended showcase will take place at the end of the session.



Art & Architecture with Parker Anderson

Dates: Begins 3/18 and ends 5/13. No classes during Spring Break (4/8).

Time: 1:40-2:40 pm (60-minute class)

Location: Rm 18

Fee: \$150

Class Size: Minimum: 6, Maximum: 15

About This class: Part math, part science, and part art, this class combines the fascinating worlds of art and architecture as students create building-themed 2D and 3D projects. Students will examine iconic works of architecture while practicing architectural techniques such as creating models using assorted materials. Students will also create pictures of famous buildings and beautiful landscapes that incorporate multiple art techniques.



Nature Club with ENC

Dates: Begins 3/18 and ends 5/13. No classes during Spring Break (4/8).

Time: 1:40-2:40 pm (60-minute class)

Fee: \$95

Class Size: Minimum: 8, Maximum: 14

About This class: In this Nature Club series, students will learn about key environmental concepts - from the importance of water quality, to biodiversity, to California's native habitats and beyond! Students will meet and engage with live animals in every class, and participate in hands-on learning activities.

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THURSDAY CLASSES



Egghead Inventors with Professor Egghead

Dates: Begins 3/19 and ends 5/14. No classes during Spring Break (4/9).

Time: 2:35-3:25 pm (50-minute class)

Location: Rm 22

Fee: \$192

Class size: Minimum 8, Max 14

About This Class: The Egghead lab is in full swing this session as we replicate some of history's greatest inventions! How do compasses know which way is North? Why are helicopters able to lift off the ground? And can we really make our own hovercraft from *checks lab notes*... balloons and CDs? With a huge variety of hands-on take-home experiments, we'll dive into the science behind what makes these inventions tick. From catapults to rocket ships and everything in between, there's no shortage of discoveries to be made this session with Professor Egghead!



Play Golf by TGA Junior Golf

Dates: Begins 3/19 and ends 5/14. No classes during Spring Break (4/9).

Time: 2:35-3:25 pm (50-minute class)

Location: Field

Fee: \$180

Class Size: Minimum: 4, **Maximum:** 18

About This Class: This class will cover all the fundamentals of golf. We start with G.A.S.P. Grip, Aim, Stance, Posture to install the basics for every student. We will then slowly build the swing starting with pitch and chip shots. Next we move onto half swing and then add a small hinge for L swing. We will wrap up with a full swing. Each week students will work on making solid contact as they increase swing length. Instructors will toss in life lessons and STEM Principals throughout the lessons to keep the kids having fun and learning. TGA supplies all necessary equipment (golf clubs, astro turf hitting surface, whiffle or nerf golf balls), so the kids need only to bring a positive attitude and willingness to try something new. Looking forward to introducing students to the game of golf!



Thoughtful Theater: Little Mermaid

Dates: Begins 3/19 and ends 5/14. No classes during Spring Break (4/9).

Fee: \$255

Class Size: Minimum 5, Max 20

About This class: What if a theater experience could also be an investment in your child's emotional well-being? Through our signature Play & Pause approach, students toggle between high-energy theater games, songs and scenes from popular musicals, and calming mindfulness moments — learning to reset, refocus, and express themselves with both compassion and confidence. The session ends with a joyful, interactive presentation for families.

About This Class: Students will dive into the world of visual arts through painting, drawing, and mixed-media projects. Each session explores new techniques and themes, allowing students to express their imagination while building foundational art skills.
